- Basketball Court Storage Unit would like to purchase for gym to improve storage \$390.00. Motion passed by Gina, seconded by Jen.
- Hula Hoops dozen of them. 2 different size. Motion passed by Gina, seconded by Anna.
- Winderland structures musically equipment, balance beams, etc....all this equipment needs to be CSA approved. All of this is going to cost more than the school initially thought. PAC may need to help with fundraising for this.

Hot Lunch \$1799.00 - outdoor picnic Some concern brought forward that Hot Lunch is not happening at PAC this year. Students really really this hot lunch program and for some it is there only healthy meal that day. WES decided to not do Hot Lunch this year, with one of the main reasons being the packaging and waste it would produce due to Covid protocols.

Summit Youth Center giving money \$200/school a month for food. Use this money to put together food for kids who need it. If student doesn't have a lunch the school is prepare to give students a healthy lunch.

Fruit and Veggie Program continue to happen.

DPAC Report - Jen Cope attended in January. Cleaning supplies discussion - all products are approved by health Canada and DPAC is continuing this conversation. They will meet again in April for their AGM. 3 meetings per year.

WES School Cleaning Protocols - Spot cleaner comes in mid day to clean high touch points each day.

Brian confirmed that when the school forest was planted no extra work was done to improve the drainage. Brian has suggested to dig a dry well, filled with rocks at the major point collection, but that this expense would need to be covered by the school. This could be a potentially large expensive, with an initial budget of \$15,000.
