Hello Windermere Elementary School families,

During the school year, you should expect to see 5 learning updates about your child. This will include 3 written learning updates (student centered reporting booklets and/or report cards), and 2 informal learning updates (could include conferences with a teacher, and phone calls or emails from a teacher). Of course, your child's teacher may connect with you at any point, and we always look forward to hearing from families if there are any questions or concerns. If your child has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), you will receive learning updates in the same way as all the other parents and caregivers do, but your child may also get additional updates based on their IEP. - School Cash Online is a safe, fast and convenient web-based solution that gives parents the ability to pay for selected student items directly out of a chequing account - similar to paying by debit card.
- Parents can make payments, print, or view their receipts and their current account history.
- ✓ It takes less than 5 minutes to register.

If you have already created an account, please go to the School Cash Online home page https://sd6.schoolcashonline.com/ and select "Sign Into Your Account".

You only need one account per family-refer to step 4 to add another student to your parent account.

If you have not created an account, please follow these step-by-step instructions.

#### Step 1: To Create an Account

- a) go to the School Cash Online home page https://sd6.schoolcashonline.com/

   and select the "Register" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps
- \*For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters, one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.

#### Step 2: Confirmation Email

- a) A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you.
- b) Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account. The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

#### Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Select the School Name from the drop down menu
- b) Enter Your Child's Name & Birth Date
- c) Select Continue
- d) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue
- e) Your child has been added to your account

#### Step 4: Add Another Student or View Items

If you have more children, you can add up to 5 children to one parent account

- a) select "Add Student" option
- b) repeat the steps above.

To view items available for purchase

a) select the "Items" option and select the applicable students tab.
 A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.
