The fun recipes I wanted to include for you this week are two different wrap ideas.

Pb and Banana Spirals

In Grade 5 I attended a fun food recipe challenge at my school and ended up winning! 25(ish) years later this recipe is still a great option for everyone.

- 1. Spread peanut butter over a soft tortilla wrap
- 2. Peel a banana and place in the bottom 1/3 of the wrap.
- 3. Now you can add some fun toppings if you would like ie. honey, cinnamon, granola, raisins or chocolate chips.

Roll the wrap up (starting at the bottom closest to the banana) and cut into round spirals. The peanut butter on the edge will keep the wrap from unrolling.

Also this week I served chicken caesar wraps at lunch and the students seemed to LOVE them!

Chicken Caesar Wraps

- 1. Spread caesar salad dressing over a soft tortilla wrap.
- 2. Add chicken deli meat or thinly sliced chicken pieces.
- 3. Top with a nice amount of romaine lettuce.

Roll up and enjoy!
