Banana Crumble Muffins (Makes 12 muffins)

1.5 cups of ripe banana's (about 3-4 bananas)	Crumb topping (optional)

Muffin Instructions:

- Heat oven to 425F
- Mash banana in a large bowl with a fork until no large lumps
- Mix in oil and melted butter
- Mix in both of the sugars
- Add the eggs, buttermilk, and vanilla and mix
- In a small bowl mix flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt together
- Add dry ingredients to wet ingredients and gently mix together (do not over mix or you will get a tough muffin)
- Scoop into lined muffin pans top with a tbsp of crumble
- Bake for 18-22 min or until a toothpick comes out clean
