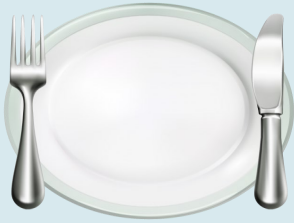

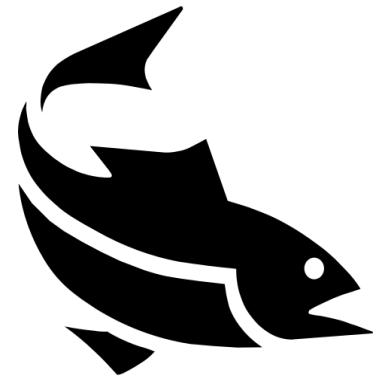


Salmon Release at Athalmer Bridge Friday, May 23, 2024
